Our Priest Missioner, Tony, the Wardens and Vestry have agreed that following the secularisation service at St Nicholas' last Sunday, our first Sunday service in the Parish will be on 19th June at St Michael's. This service will mark our coming together as one faith community and celebrate the reopening of the refurbished church.

From a practical point of view, taking this two week break will enable the final tasks to be completed in the upgrade of St Michael's. But also, importantly, it will allow us all to take time to pray about and prepare for our common life together as one united faith community.

As there won't be a Sunday service in the parish this Sunday or next, parishioners may like to join another congregation to celebrate the Day of Pentecost on Sunday 5th June and Trinity Sunday on 12th June.

Here are some options:

The Cathedral (no Vaccine Pass required) – Sunday services are at 8am, 10am & 6pm

Holy Cross, St Kilda (Vaccine Pass only) – the Sunday service is at 11am

St Peter's, Caversham (no Vaccine Pass required) – Sunday services are at 8am, 10.30am & 5pm on 5th June, and 8am & 10.30am on 12th June

St Luke's on the Taieri (no Vaccine Pass required) – the Sunday service is at 10am

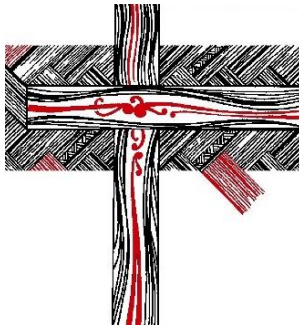
